- $\cdot\,$ Take 1st RIGHT onto Aska Road. Go 13.2 miles to end of Aska.
- $\cdot\,$ Turn RIGHT onto Newport Road. Go approximately 3 miles.
- Noontootla Creek Farms Pro Shop will be on the RIGHT.
