The seminar will be geared toward the development of the Southern Appalachian gun dog. Key points being socialization, range of proper introduction techniques to include, bird, launcher, prey drive, retrieve and gun introduction. With the goal being to have proper introduction to avoid fixing problems later. Bring your bird dogs and get hands-on help.
